

SURPLUS EQUIPMENT FOR TENDER ITEMS ARE "AS IS WHERE IS"

A list of the surplus equipment is available at the Engineering and Public Works Department at 235 Park Street or by calling 902-755-8351. Equipment may be viewed at 235 Park Street New Glasgow. Digital photos of the equipment or items can be made available.

Option 1: Anyone wishing to submit a quotation on equipment or item must quote on <u>each</u> individual piece of equipment or item <u>separately</u>, in an envelope labeled <u>Surplus Equipment</u> <u>Quotation</u> with the <u>Equipment or Item Number</u> clearly visible on the envelope and on the quote. Tender response must also include bidder's name, mailing address, and contact phone number.

Option 2: Anyone wishing to submit a quotation on equipment or item must quote on <u>each</u> individual piece of equipment or item <u>separately</u>, by using a secure email confidentially to <u>brittany.fisher@newglasgow.ca</u>. The subject line of each email must contain the item number as listed in the published list. Emails containing a bid on more than one piece of equipment or item will be rejected. The email <u>must</u> contain the item number, brief description of the item, contact number for the bidder and the amount of the bid.

Please send all submissions on or before 3:00 PM on Thursday, December 14, 2023. Bidders will be notified whether successful or not within approximately 24 hours of tender closing. Successful bidders must pay the full bid amount, <u>plus HST</u> by January 4th, 2024, at 4pm. If the successful bidder does not complete the transaction by the date and time listed, the bidder's amount will be withdrawn, and the next highest bidder will be contacted.
