



PROCLAMATION
Canadian Multiculturalism Day
June 27, 2026

WHEREAS, Multiculturalism is a fundamental characteristic of the Canadian heritage; and

WHEREAS, The Town of New Glasgow is home to residents of many different cultural backgrounds, all of whom contribute to the social, economic, and cultural vibrancy of our community; and

WHEREAS, the diverse heritage and traditions of our citizens continue to enrich New Glasgow through local arts, food, music, community events, and everyday interactions; and

WHEREAS, recognizing and celebrating this diversity promotes inclusion, understanding, and respect among all people in our town; and

WHEREAS, by Order in Council P.C. 2002-1869 of October 31, 2002, the Governor in Council has directed that a proclamation be issued declaring June 27 of each year as “Canadian Multiculturalism Day”, a celebration of the contributions of Canada’s diverse people to Canadian society; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, I, Mayor Nancy Dicks, do hereby proclaim June 27, 2026, as “**Canadian Multiculturalism Day**” in the Town of New Glasgow.
