

BY-LAW NO. 1

INTERPRETATION BY-LAW

1(1) This By-law shall be known and may be cited as the "Interpretation By-law" of the Town of New Glasgow.

(2) In all By-laws of the Town of New Glasgow, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions may be construed in the manner in this section mentioned:

(a) "By-law" means any by-law, or portion thereof, of the Town of New Glasgow, passed as a By-law by the Town Council of the Town of New Glasgow and approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

(b) "Chairperson" used in respect to the Town Council, means the Mayor, Deputy Mayor, or presiding Councillor presiding at any meeting of the Council of the Town.

(c) "Clerk" used in respect to the Town Clerk, means the Town Clerk of the Town of New Glasgow.

(d) "Company" means a body corporate.

(e) "Councillor" or "Member" means a duly elected Councillor of the Town Council of the Town of New Glasgow pursuant to provisions of the Municipal Elections Act.

(f) "Council" means the Council of the Town, as determined and elected pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Elections Act.

(g) "Mayor" means the Mayor of the Town as determined pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Elections Act.

(h) "Owner", when used in relation to any property within the Town, includes an agent having the care or control of any such property of an absent owner.

(i) "Street" includes every street, highway, road, lane, footway, thoroughfare, alley, By-way, passage, court, square, sidewalk, parking place or bridge, and every part thereof, lawfully used by the public and situated within the Town of New Glasgow.

(j) "Town" means the Town of New Glasgow.

(k) "Town Hall" means the building in which the Town Clerk of the Town has his office, and in which the Town Council of the Town meets.


(l) "Town Solicitor" means the Town Solicitor of the Town as appointed pursuant to the Towns Act.

2. By this Section the Town of New Glasgow hereby adopts and incorporates into all its By-laws, present and future, the interpretation provisions of the Interpretation Act, R.S.N.S. 1989, c. 235 as amended, insofar as applicable, and the rules of interpretation therein given to words, expressions and phrases shall apply in the same manner and to the same effect as all such words, expressions and phrases contained in all Town By-laws, both present and future, except insofar as the same are clearly inconsistent with the context of said By-laws. Where the context requires, words importing the singular or masculine gender shall include the plural, feminine and neutral genders.


